

Welcome to the Drama Club!

We're excited to have you join us. To help make this club a fun, safe, and respectful place for everyone, we ask that both students and parents read and agree to the following expectations.

CLUB RULES

1. Be Kind and Encouraging

- I will support and encourage my fellow Drama Club members.
- I understand that bullying of any kind is not allowed.

2. Respect Others

- I will treat all club leaders, volunteers, and other members with kindness.
- I will respect the church we meet in and any guest speakers.
- I will speak and act respectfully at all times, including during rehearsals, meetings, performances, and field trips.

3. Be Safe and Responsible

- I will not damage property.
- I will not engage in roughhousing or unsafe behavior.
- I will use appropriate language and avoid inappropriate or coarse joking.

4. Behavior Expectations

- I understand that bullying, damaging property, or inappropriate behavior will lead to immediate removal from the club without warning.
- I understand that disruptive behavior may result in one warning, and continued disruption may lead to removal.

5. Attendance

- I may miss up to **two meetings per semester**.
- **Missing more than two meetings may result in removal from the club or the loss of a role in the final performance.**
- Emergencies will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
- I understand that regular attendance is important, especially when preparing for performances.

6. Commitment

- If I quit during a semester, I may return the following year but must show that I am ready to commit.
- If I choose to stop participating at the end of the first semester and I decide not to participate in the second semester, that is **not** considered quitting. Kids are not required to participate in the Spring Performance if they choose not to but they must inform the Director of this before the spring semester starts.
- If I audition and choose not to continue because I did not get the role I wanted,**or because my schedule is too busy**, this **is** considered quitting. I understand that I will not be eligible for a speaking role the following year.

7. Roles and Costumes

- I understand that **every role is important**, and I will not grumble or complain about the part I receive.
- **Parents and students** must be respectful of all casting decisions. Complaints — public or private — will not be tolerated.
- **Parents and students will not complain about the cost of events, costumes or materials.** The club works to keep costs minimal and appreciates a positive,

flexible attitude from all families.

PARENT INVOLVEMENT

Drama Club is a team effort, and we rely on the support of families to make events and performances successful.

As a parent or guardian, I understand that Drama Club is a group effort and agree to:

- Support my child and the club with a positive attitude.
 - Not complain or express dissatisfaction about roles or casting decisions.
 - Parents will not complain about the cost of events, costumes or materials.
 - Volunteer during rehearsals and performances when needed.
 - Assist with field trips, parties, or events throughout the year.
 - Communicate with leaders and respond to volunteer sign-ups or requests as needed.
